Safety First/Important!

This light fitting is suitable for indoor use only. It should not be fitted to newly painted or plastered surfaces as this may cause discolouration of the finish.

Please read the following carefully.

Important!

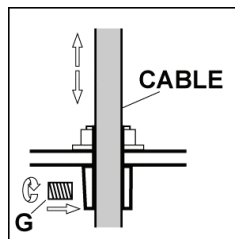
This light fitting must be connected to the earth supply. If your lighting circuit does not have an earth, ask a qualified electrician to provide an earth facility.

- ★ To prevent electrocution switch off at the mains supply before installing or maintaining this fitting. Ensure other persons cannot restore the electricity supply without your knowledge.
- ★ To avoid damage to concealed wiring during installation, establish the direction of the supply cable before drilling fixing holes.
- ★ This fitting should be fitted to a lighting supply with protected 5 Amp fuse or equivalent circuit breaker.
- ★ Always be sure to use the correct type and wattage of bulbs as indicated on the fitting. Never exceed the wattage stated.
When changing the bulb, always switch off at the mains and allow the old bulb to cool down before handling. Dispose of used bulbs carefully.

Adjusting the cable to the desired length

It is possible to adjust the drop of the pendant.

1. Loosen the grub screw G below the ceiling plate to free the suspension cable
2. Adjust the cable to the desired height.
3. Tighten the grub screw to lock the cable at the new height.
4. Coil the excess wire inside the ceiling cup.



Before starting

Please read through these instructions before commencing work, and keep them for future reference.

Fixing instructions

Step 1

Make sure you have the following items which are required to install this light fitting:

- ❖ Small electrical screwdriver & crosshead screwdriver
- ❖ Insulating tape

Step 2

Warning!

Before commencing installation, isolate the circuit to be used by removing the fuse or circuit breaker at the consumer distribution unit.

Step 3

Remove the existing light fitting and make sure that there is a joist or other solid mounting at the point of fixing. This is necessary to take the weight of the fitting.

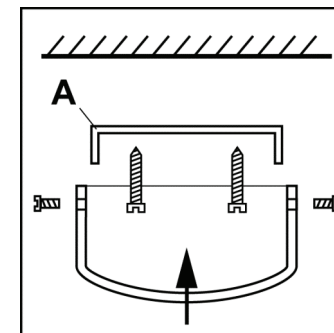
Step 4

Unscrew the small screws and detach the mounting bracket **A** from the fitting.

Step 5

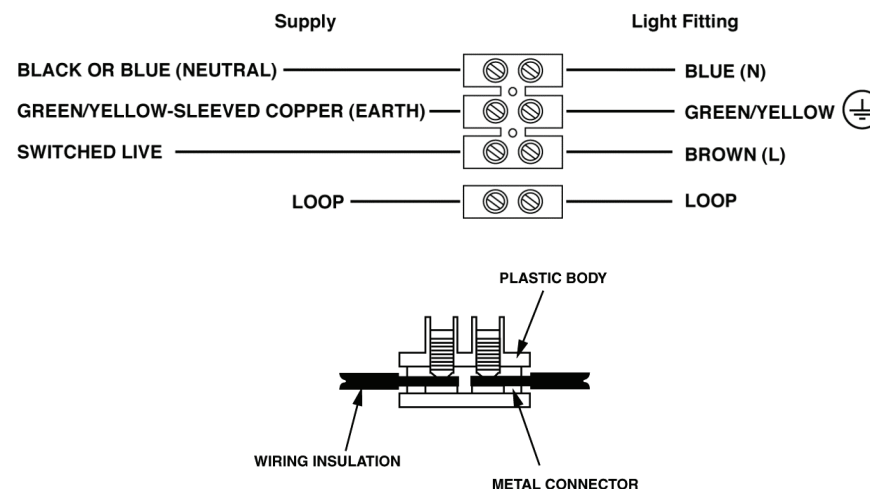
Taking care not to damage any house wiring, screw the mounting bracket to the ceiling using the screws supplied.

The screws should penetrate the ceiling joist by at least 2cm.



Step 6

❖ Using the connector block supplied, connect the wires in the following way:



A fourth terminal is provided for loop in/out connections if required.

Check that....

- ❖ You have correctly identified the house wires.
- ❖ The connections are tight.
- ❖ No loose strands have been left out of the connection block.

Step 7 – IMPORTANT!

Wrap two layers of electrical insulation tape around the loop connection block and around the wiring 2cm each side of the loop connection block.

Step 8

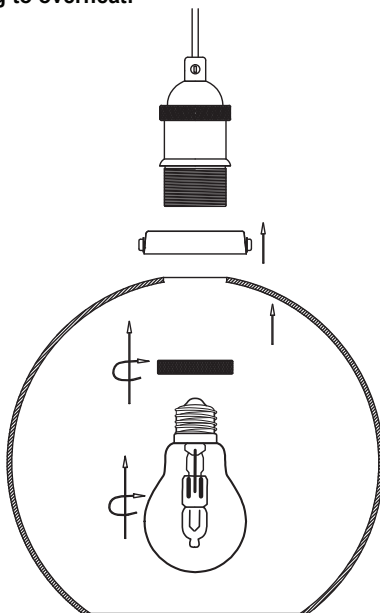
Offer the fitting up to the mounting bracket and secure the fitting to the bracket by replacing the screws.

Selecting the correct lightbulb

- ❖ Maximum wattage - 10 Watts.
- ❖ Lightbulb shape - GLS.
- ❖ Lightbulb cap shape – Edison screw cap (E27).



Do not exceed the maximum wattage or use a different shape of lightbulb. This may cause your light fitting to overheat.

**Switch on!**

You may now switch the electricity back on. We are sure you will be pleased with your new light fitting.

Cleaning care

We recommend cleaning with a soft dry cloth.

Don't use abrasive materials as these may affect the finish.

Safety information

For your safety, please remember the following:

Always switch off the supply before changing lightbulbs or cleaning.

Allow bulbs to cool down before handling.
